

Protect yourself from Medicare drug plan marketing fraud.

Most Medicare drug plans are sold by responsible Insurance Agents.
But some agents do not follow the rules.

Here are some tips:

- Talking to an agent does **NOT** mean that you have to buy his or her plan.
- You can say **NO!**
- A MMAP Counselor can help you compare plans and sign you up for a plan that meets your needs.

- Watch out for agents who say that they have a plan “preferred by Medicare”.
- Medicare does **NOT** recommend drug plans.
- A MMAP Counselor can help you sort through your Medicare drug plan choices.

- Agents may **NOT** sell their plans door-to-door or make cold calls to would-be clients.
- You must give your written okay before an agent can talk with you.
- A MMAP Counselor can help you report an agent who is not following the rules.
