What is Medicare Fraud?

Examples

- Billing Medicare for medical supplies that have been returned to the company
- Billing Medicare for services and supplies that were never provided
- Submitting claims for unnecessary services or procedures
- Using another person's Medicare card to get medical care
- Falsifying claim forms to get paid for services not provided
- Billing Medicare for the same service twice
- Billing Medicare for non-approved services by calling them approved services

Take Action!

Take an active role in your own health care expenses and save your Medicare dollars.

Protect

- Keep a record of your doctor visits, tests, and procedures in your personal health care journal
- Do not give out your Medicare number or ANY personal information to people who call you or come to your door
- Do not do business with providers not known to you

Detect

- Read your Medicare Summary Notices (MSN). Look for mistakes and services that were not ordered by your doctor

Report

- Call your provider FIRST if you have questions
- Call MMAP at **1-800-803-7174** if you suspect fraud or have any questions

What is MMAP?

MMAP is a free service that can help you make informed health benefit decisions.

Volunteer counselors can help you:

- Understand Medicare bills
- Understand insurance choices
- Report fraud and suspicious billing
